Here's what you gotta do:

#1 You Need To Register With Your Pack

#2 You Also Need ADULT Den Walkers

Each Tiger Cub MUST have their Adult Partner with them. Wolf, Bear & Webelos Scouts need ONE adult per FOUR youth. The same ADULT DEN WALKER doesn't need to attend each day, BUT the same ratio of adult to youth needs to happen each day.

ADULTS need to fill out registration and health/medical forms. Every ADULT DEN WALKER on the premises needs to have both a registration and medical form filled out and turned in. This is vital and cannot be neglected.

Things you need to bring to Day Camp:

Water Bottle – YOU MUST BRING A WATER BOTTLE TO DAY CAMP.

Swimsuit & towel - Swimming on Thursday!

Adults – Got to have them so BE PREPARED and bring them!

Lunch – Make it a good one! Water & lemonade will be available.

Money – A trading post will be on site.
